The fee includes boarding, lodging, laundry, routine on site medical attention, free email and web access.

Overseas/Afro Asian student is defined as a person who holds citizenship of countries other than India and SAARC countries. Students from SAARC may pay in INR(₹) or equivalent amount in US \$.

Imprest account caters to expenses such as medical, pocket money, books and stationery, uniform, excursions and special skills sports like shooting etc. (to include coaching and participation).

All fees and charges are to be paid only by cash, 'Pay Order' or 'Demand Draft' in favor of 'SelaQui International School' payable at Dehra Dun. Payment by cheque is not acceptable.

Item Supplied by the School at cost are adjusted against Imprest Account.

Fee for the coming academic year becomes payable on 01 May every year and may be paid by 31 May in full. However, the School accepts payment of fee in two equal halves, i.e. as on 01 May for the 1st term and as on 01 Nov, payable by 30 Nov for the 2nd term. Penalty, as given below, is levied if fees and other outstanding dues are not paid in time.

If the fee or Imprest dues are not paid in accordance with the stipulated date, a fine of ₹1000 will be imposed. For those who fail to clear the dues even after 30 days of delay, a penalty of ₹5000 will be levied.

Any delay beyond 2 months may lead to the name of student being struck off the school rolls. If Parents' wish their ward to continue, it shall be treated as fresh admission.

It will be mandatory for Parent / Ward to clear the Imprest dues every three months and maintain their balance at ₹40,000, US\$ 2000 for overseas students.

Withdrawal Rules

If a child is withdrawn from the school at any time the following rules apply:

1. Notice of withdrawal must be given at least 30 days prior to the end of term. There will be a fine of ₹10,000 (US \$ 500 for overseas students) for a shorter notice period or when the student is withdrawn during mid academic year.
2. If a child is withdrawn / or asked to leave, once terms starts, full fee for the term, shall become payable.
3. If a child is withdrawn temporarily for a term, reason acceptable to the Headmaster and is given seat, retention fee of ₹50,000 (US\$ 2,500 for overseas students) per term will be payable. Seat retention beyond one term is not permissible.
