

An Online test is a test that is taken on a computer. It is used to determine a student's suitability for the Bansal Classes Gurukul Residential Program at SelaQui International School, Dehradun.

Some important facts about online tests:

- SELECTION
  - Online tests carry the same weightage as a paper based test. Students who appear for online tests are considered equal to those who appear for paper based tests
  - The marking of an online test is done in the same manner as that of a paper based test. Final marks are awarded on the same scale
  - Scholarships are available for online test takers too
  - Selection into the Gurukul Residential Program is the same for online test takers as for paper test takers
  
- TAKING THE TEST
  - Taking the online test is as simple as checking your email
  - You have to be prepared for an online test as you would for a paper test
  - You will be taking the test at home, or at a friends or relatives house, or at a computer center
  - The test will be timed like any other test
  - You will be logging into our website for your test, with a username and password that will be provided to you
  - Keep some rough paper and a pen/ pencil with you to solve the questions, if you need to
  - Do not keep any books, reference material, or notes with you. You have to be honest while taking this test.
  - Do not take help from anyone, like a teacher or a friend
  - You will read the question, and select the correct answer from the choices given
  - The correct choice is selected by clicking it with the mouse
  - You can skip a question if you don't know the correct answer, or want to come back to it later
  - You can review your whole test before submitting it
  - The answersheet is visible on the right side of the screen to show you what answers you have selected for all the questions
  - At the end, when you are satisfied with your performance, you click on 'Submit' to end the test
  
- WHAT DO I NEED TO TAKE THE TEST
  - A computer which is running Windows XP (minimum)
  - Power backup in case there is a power failure
  - An internet connection
  - A quiet room with no disturbance for 3 hours
  - Honesty so that you don't cheat

- WHAT IF SOMETHING GOES WRONG

- Power Failure: If your power fails, your power backup can keep your test going till around 20 minutes. See if you can get a generator or an inverter to help you take this test, if there are frequent power cuts in your area
- Internet Failure: These days, most people use wireless internet, like Reliance or Tata Photon mobile internet. These connections usually don't fail, but please ensure that you have enough balance on your mobile card to take the test. A recharge of Rs 200 should be more than enough

Please note that the online test is being run by a central, high-end server. This is a master computer that is running the test on your computer as well as on several hundreds of other computers at the same time. This server is saving your test as you go from one question to the next. Therefore, if, for some reason, your computer shuts down (because of some power cut or a technical fault), the questions you have answered till now will be saved. All you need to do is call us and let us know, so we can restart your test once your technical fault has been corrected. Your test will start from the question where you left it.

- ADVANTAGES OF THE ONLINE TEST

- The biggest advantage is that you don't have to travel anywhere. This means saving of time and money
- You can take the test at home. If you don't have a computer at home, you can take the test at a friends house or a relatives house, where they have a computer
- You actually save time, since you don't have to write anything, or fill out the OMR sheets with a pencil. All you have to do is click
