Overseas student is defined as a person who holds citizenship of countries other than India, Bhutan & Nepal.

Imprest account caters to expenses such as medical, pocket money, excursions and other expenses. It will be mandatory for parents to clear the imprest bill of their wards regularly and a balance of Rs. 70,000 has to be maintained in the beginning of each term. Under no circumstances it should fall below Rs.10,000 at any point of time.

All fee and charges are to be paid online as per the details available on school website.

Fee for coming academic year becomes payable on 1st Feb every year and may be paid by 28th Feb, in full. However, the school accepts payment of fee in two equal halves, i.e. as on 1st Feb payable by 28th Feb for the 1st term and as on 1st Aug payable by 31st Aug for the 2nd term.

Penalty, as given below, is levied if fees are not paid on time.

Fees & Imprest have to be paid in full by the due date[^], after which there will be a late fine of Rs 1,000/per day **on fee only**. The student name will be stuck off the rolls after 1 month of the due date[^] (e.g. for 1st term, fee bill will be issued by 1st Feb (beginning of month) due date[^] will be 28th Feb (end of month) late fine of 1,000 per day is effective from 1st March - 31st March, cancellation of admission after 31st March.) If parents wish their ward to continue, it shall be treated as fresh admission.

[^] Due date means last day of payment.

If a child is withdrawn from the school at any time, the following rules apply:

- 1. Notice of withdrawal must be given at least 90 days prior to the end of academic year (before December 31st).**
There will be a fine of Rs. 50,000, (US\$ 1000 for overseas students) for a shorter notice period or when the student is withdrawn mid-session.
- 2. If a child is withdrawn or asked to leave for any disciplinary issues once term starts, full fee for the term shall become payable. None of the fee is refundable except the amount left in imprest and the caution money.**
- 3. Caution money should be claimed by the ward's (student's) parents/ legal guardians within a period of two (2) years, after leaving school, else it will be forfeited.**

Fees may be revised every year.
